

Let's make...



The Boat Race

You will need:

1. Little Yoghurt Pot
2. A4 foam sheet
3. Wooden skewer
4. Play-doh or blue tac ball
5. Scissors

Instructions:

1. Make a square out of your piece of foam sheet by folding one corner up.
2. Put the play-doh or blue tac ball in the yoghurt pot and place in the centre of the centre of the square foam. Fold each corner to the centre of the pot.
3. With the sharp end of the skewer, pierce the foam, pinning all corners together.
4. Place the skewer in the pot, using play-doh or blue tac to hold into place.

**Don't throw the excess away!
This will become the sail.**

**Make sure the holes in the
corners are facing up.**

5. Using the left over foam, pierce each portrait edge with the skewer, creating your sail.

**Don't forget to
decorate your sail!**

6. Filling a large plastic tub, paddling pool or even the bath... it's race time!
7. Create as much wind as you can to get your boat to the other side first!
